BARDS OF THE ST IVES AREA/BERDH A'N RANNDIR PORTHIA

To commemorate the 2010 Gorsedd taking place in St Ives, Gorsedd Kernow has put together a publication which details the lives of fifty-three deceased bards who lived and worked in the St Ives area. This is the first in a planned series of publications covering the area in which the annual Gorsedd Kernow is held.

St Ives boasts some very distinguished bards. There were poets, potters, historians, sculptors, industrialists, artists, musicians, teachers, antiquarians and Cornish speakers. They included John Tucker Barber, Michael Cardew, Edward Stanley Cock, Albert Guthrie, Barbara Hepworth, James Frederick Holman, Elizabeth Beryl James, Peter Lanyon, Bernard Leach, John Hobson Matthews, Robert Morton Nance, Cyril Noall, Borlase Smart and Herbert Thomas.

Bards of the St Ives Area/Berth a'n Ranndir Porthia, which features many photographs, has been researched and compiled by members of the Gorsedd Archives Sub-Committee and volunteers from the St Ives Archive Study Centre. It also contains an introduction by Grand Bard, Mick Paynter.

The book will be launched by the Grand Bard on Friday 3rd September at St Ives Guildhall, Street-an-Pol, during the Eisteddfod. Copies may be ordered in advance from 1st September or collected from the Gorsedd stall on the 3rd.
